

**ACCT. 2990, BUSINESS LAW I

Legal Environment, Online Commerce, Business Ethics, and International Issues

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COURSE OBJECTIVE: This is an introductory course in Business Law designed to acquaint the student with some background knowledge of how the law works, and to acquaint him/her with a legal vocabulary, and a knowledge of our basic legal system.

The course deals with introductory materials pertaining to the areas of the law described on the attached pages.
